**Program**

Mary Tilton presented on how to share work on Zoom. She has been doing watercolors for 9 years, which coincides with the birth of her granddaughter. Watercolorists work from light to dark and other mediums work from dark to light. She used Zoom presentation capabilities to show her watercolor process by beginning with a value study, moving to a light wash, then medium values, and finally adding darks.
